- Performance time may not exceed five minutes.
- List the title and composer for your piece below. If we do not receive this information, it will not be included in the printed program and you will have to announce your selection from the stage.
- Kaufman Music Center will provide an accompanist, if needed. One rehearsal is included; however, students are responsible for scheduling the rehearsal directly with the accompanist.
